Curriculum Spring Term

For the first two weeks we have been doing targeted observations on our key children so we can develop our curriculum to each child's individual needs.

WB 22nd Jan For two weeks we will be exploring the different sounds that musical instrument's make and listening to different genres of music. If there are any parents that would like to share their musical talents or have instruments that they could bring in for the children to see, please get in touch.

The children will be making their own musical instruments using junk modelling and other available resources.

WB Feb 5th For two weeks we will be celebrating Chinese New Year. We will be watching and learning about the Chinese New Year story and will watch these videos over the 2 weeks at circle time and we will be learning to recite numbers 1-10 in Mandarin. Alongside this we will be retelling the story using stick puppets.

In the tuff tray we will have different coloured noodles with scissors and chopsticks to encourage role play and fine motor skills.

We will also have mark making trays so the children can try out some Chinese writing using a variety of resources such as brushes, cotton buds, sticks and their fingers!

All of our activities will involve all seven areas of learning & development. (Expressive arts & design, Understanding the World, Maths, Literacy, Physical, Personal, Social & Emotional and Communication & Language)

At snack time the children will be trying different food such as rice, noodles, prawn crackers etc

Pre-school have been using the book 'Room on the Broom' as a base for activities, which include:

-Listening to the story(Communication & Language, listening & attention and literacy)

-Making puppets of the characters in the story.(Expressive art and design, physical development)

-Acting out and retelling the story, using their puppets.(Literacy, Communication & Language, Physical)

-Working as a group to create a wall picture to illustrate the story.(Personal, Social & emotional, Expressive art & design)

-We will include some maths with how big and strong the broom needs to be to fit everyone on, also counting how many characters there are and who was biggest/heaviest/lightest/smallest etc.

Chinese New Year

We will be celebrating Chinese New Year week beginning 5th Feb and will be having a lady from the Mando school come in on Wed 7th Feb to do a workshop with the children.

If your child is not normally in that day, please let us know if you would like them to attend.

If possible, we would like the children to be wearing something red on the day. **Pancake Day Tues 13th Feb!** We will be making pancakes with the children and having them for snack with various toppings.
